ESPRESSO PAINT



If you are meeting in a cafe, buy one shot of espresso. (or you can purchase this in advance, espresso keeps well in your freezer). You won't need a lot.

MATERIALS:

A shot of espresso

A cup of water

Two round tip brushes

2 pencils

2 black pens

4 paper towels or napkins for dabbing your brush

Multi-media or watercolor paper (2 sheets)

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Take a moment to write down key thoughts or highlights from your time together that you want to remember on one side of the watercolor paper.
- 2. With a pencil quickly draw a picture that ties in with that thought.
- 3. There are two ways to espresso paint
 - a. Wet
 - Then take a round tip brush and dip it in the water
 - ii. Wet wherever you would like the espresso to go on the page (so you are first painting the image or part of it with water)
 - iii. Then dip your brush into the espresso
 - iv. And put a drop of the espresso on the part of your page you wet. The espresso will spread to fill the area.
 - v. You can determine how dark you want an area to be by how much espresso you put on to the page.
 - vi. Also by letting one area dry as you work in another area you can go back and add more espresso and this can result in beautiful shading
 - b. Dry
 - i. Dip your round tip brush directly into the espresso paint
 - ii. Paint it directly onto the dry page
 - iii. As the paint dries you can add additional layers
- 4. Keep listening to hear what the Lord wants to say to you as you do this.
- 5. When you are done creating, share your pictures with each other.
- Pray Thanking the Lord for what He's communicated to you and asking for his grace to live out what He's invited each of you to do in response..
