God's Promise of Salvation
Collection 2: Week 2

1. Connect
 - a. How was your week?
 - b. Highlights from last week they remember?
 - c. Any new thoughts on God's promises?
2. Image Gallery
 - a. Select an image from the image gallery. When you think of salvation what comes to mind? Why?
3. Read John 1:12-13.
 - a. What image did John have in mind when he wrote this verse?
 - b. Why do you think he selected this?
4. Write John 1:12-13 on a card
 - a. Begin with Title: God's Promise of Salvation
 - b. Next Line put the reference: John 1:12-13
 - c. Write the verse phrase by phrase
 - d. Then put the reference again at the bottom of the card: John 1:12-13
5. Memorize John 1:12-13
 - a. phrase by phrase, one phrase at a time,
 - b. reviewing each time what came before
 - c. until they can quote the whole verse word perfectly.
6. Bible study
 - a. Now do the Bible study in chapter 1 of Tackle 'n Trust seeking to understand what has God promised
7. Share Your Stories of Becoming A child of God
 - a. Be sure to give a good bit of time letting them share their story of becoming a child of God and be ready to share your story too. (NOTE: you cannot assume just because they want to meet with you that they are a child of God, listen to hear where they are at)
8. Consider:
 - a. What difference can it make in your life to really remember and embrace at the heart level that you are God's child?
9. Challenge:
 - a. them to review John 1:12-13 100 times this week
10. Practical Tool:
 - a. On the back of their verse card have them create a grid where they can check off each time they review their verse. Make certain they understand even though they may be able to quote their verse word perfectly right now it's only in their short term memory and can easily be forgotten. They can not consider to have this verse memorized until they have quoted it 100 times word perfect out loud. NOTE: that out loud part is important and it's best if they quote it out loud to people around them.
11. Discuss ways they might be able to do this
 - a. (eg., standing in line or waiting for a class or meeting to start ask someone to check them on their verse - you never know what conversations this might get going!)
12. Pray giving thanks to God for this incredible gift of becoming His child
