God's Promise of Answered Prayer
Collection 2: Week 3

1. Connect

- a. What difference did it make in your life this week to remember you are a child of God?
- b. How much have you embraced this at the heart level? Why? Why not?

2. Review verses together:

- a. How did it go reviewing John 1:12-13 this week?
 - i. Note be careful to not let this be shaming if she hasn't reviewed, I like to share the example of a baby learning how to walk. Remember parents rejoice whenever a step forward is taken, they expect they child will fall down.
 - ii. I like to share how it helps me to consider what got in the way of me doing what I planned to do. What can I learn from it and how that can help me keep growing in the future. Ask what did she learn from this past week. Share how your reviewing went and how these verses as you are remembering them are impacting your life.
 - iii. Celebrate any steps forward.
- b. Get out your verse cards and have them in hand as you check each other. Let her check you first.
 - i. John 1:12-13

3. Visual

- a. When you think about prayer, especially asking God for something, what picture comes to mind? Take a moment so you each can draw a quick sketch of that picture, then share your pictures with each other.
- b. Why did you select that picture? (each of you share)

4. Training

- a. Create a Verse Card
 - i. Write on a 3x5 card the Title: God's Promise of Answered Prayer
 - ii. Then write the Reference: 1 John 1:9
 - iii. Write the verse phrase by phrase (See example in Tackle n Trust)
 - iv. The write the Reference again at the bottom of the card: 1 John 1:9
- b. Memorize the Verse, phrase by phrase, do not add a new phrase until you've each quoted the previous phrase(s) word perfect three times. Go back and forth as you do this.

- c. Tip: Make certain whoever is not quoting the verse is holding up the verse card checking to make sure it's quoted word perfect. When you memorize phrase by phrase it can be easy to get confused - even if you've had the verse memorized for years - and you don't want to memorize it wrong!

5. Time In God's Word

- a. Chapter 3 Tackle N' Trust
 - i. What has God promised?
 - ii. What is our part?

6. Application

- a. What can it practically look like for you to take God up on this promise this week?
 - i. For example: I like to keep a list of what I'm asking God for, adding to the list every day. Then as God answers I write the answer next to the request. It's fascinating to see how the list grows. And remember, not yet and I have something better for you are both answers! Be sure to record the something better when that happens!
- b. Share what you plan to do, too!

7. Challenge

- a. Review 1 John 1:9 ten times a day every day this week
- b. Keep reviewing John 1:12-13 once a day this week
